The brass ensemble hr-brass has a flexible instrumentar and performs as a sextet up to nineteen musicians.

The ensemble's repertoire includes, among many others, "Eine kleine Nachtmusik", "Feuerwerksmusik", "Wassermusik", "Bilder einer Ausstellung", music from "West Side Story", "Porgy and Bess", from operas (Verdi, Rossini, Mozart) or operetta ("Zigeunerbaron" by Johann Strauß).
