Peter Bruns | violoncello and conductor

This orchestra is characterised by its sophisticated programming, outstanding homogenous sound and sheer joy in music making. Directed by their cellist, Peter Bruns, this ensemble from Leipzig plays with world renowned soloists in Germany and internationally.



The Mendelssohn Chamber Orchestra Leipzig itself is absolutely cosmopolitan; they tour around the entire world from Australia to South America. There the musicians have the opportunity to try out and modify a programme - and so this CD is coagulated concert atmosphere, hardly any cuts were necessary, as the programme has really sunk in. This kind of liveliness is found very rarely in a CD production.
