The year 2024 marked thirty years since the fall of apartheid in South Africa. To frame these commissions, the quartet has chosen works symbolising hope and transformation. Both the lark and spring symbolise optimism and the dawn of the new, as so wonderfully expressed in these works by Haydn and Mozart. And few compositions express a deep sense of spiritual humanism and triumph over adversity as Beethoven's monumental late quartets.

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
