Their programmes, which also include commissions, offer an entertaining listening experience with the highest musical standards. Salaputia Brass performs its wittily moderated programmes at the Mozartfest Würzburg, the Heidelberger Frühling, the Philharmonies in Cologne, Essen and Hamburg, as well as the Schleswig-Holstein Musik Festival and the Rheingau Musik Festival.

Following the CDs "Sounds of Evolution" and "Signals from Heaven" (with Jeroen Berwaerts - trumpet and jazz vocals), "Roots" was released with works by English composers from Holborne to John Lennon and a James Bond medley, "Hungarian Pictures" and "Chansons sans paroles" with works from the Renaissance to Zaz and well-known chansons such as La vie en rose and Les Champs-Elysées.
