With the new Schubert album "Lebensmuth", the Signum Quartett wants to pay homage to the tremendous resilience of spirit which he displayed in his final years. Schubert writes with the greatest and most subtle personal profundity, and of the traumas of war with shattering militaristic fanfares and the abysses which ensue. Yet there is not merely a bittersweet recollection of an innocent, carefree past, there is also a blazing triumph over adversity and an ineluctable forward momentum.

Priault Rainier is without a doubt one of the most important female composers of the 20th century. She was born in 1903 in South Africa and studied the violin at the RAM in London, later composition with Nadia Boulanger in Paris. In 1943 Priault Rainier was appointed professor of composition at the Royal Academy of Music. The Signum Quartett have recorded her Quartet for Strings for our new ECM album "glimpses".

The year 2024 marked thirty years since the fall of apartheid in South Africa. The Signum Quartet has celebrated this "glorious human achievement" (Mandela) and the conflicts contained therein by inviting some of South Africa's most original and powerful voices to reflect on their own experiences and journeys since 1994, weaving a rich musical tapestry as diverse as the country itself.

To frame these commissions, the quartet has chosen works symbolising hope and transformation. Both the lark and spring symbolise optimism and the dawn of the new, as so wonderfully expressed in these works by Haydn and Mozart. And few compositions express a deep sense of spiritual humanism and triumph over adversity as Beethoven's monumental late quartets.
